

MFC0003 – Ketchikan Sea Base Ops

This is RTMM - Ketchikan Center Sea Base Ops. Ketchikan Center is the center of many of our activities and in the heart of our prime scenery locations: Tongass Fjords, ORBX Alaska Regions and the largest scenery pieces is RTMM with RTMM Misty's Place just around the corner from Ketchikan.

We will explore many different areas from great fishing spots, outlying/remote cabins, seaplane bases as well as rugged natural scenery: Harbors, rivers, gorges, mountain ranges and more all in a radius area of @ 100 nm from Ketchikan SPB. On our trip, it is our task to transport fishermen to the outlying areas for some prime Halibut, Salmon and bottom fishing – accessible by water hence this is strictly a sea plan base operation. Note: each flight leg has one stop-over location which is also a water mooring.

Aircraft: Float plane or amphibian is required and since we are site seeing this scenic area along the way as we transport the fishermen to various locations: "low & slow" is the only way to go! The aircraft must be a single engine non-turbo prop fixed wing: IE: DHC2 Beaver Float/Amph*, Cessna C185, or equivalent. For helicopter pilots: If you prefer a rotorcraft, go for it. Bush chopper must be equipped with floats (non-military) only.
