

MFC0005 Barnstormers

"Barnstormers" is a great scenic journey and RTMM has created an add-on scenery package for this area and more. This is an updated and re-introduced scenery location done by Xavier Carre' with some additional scenery locations by Chris Losh. Add the RTMM creations and designs and it becomes a great scenery area to explore.

It has been have combined into a single rendering, so read the instructions carefully. This is Bush Flying at its BEST! A beautiful high plateau area in British Columbia: The Tweedsmuir-Nechako Area of PFJ, deceptively "simple" for navigating, and 100% capable of getting you completely LOST!

Combined, the package has over 30 locations with several new small airports. The attention to detail is excellent. Carefully go through the Readme.pdf that is enclosed in the download and you will have a good preview of what enjoyment you are going to have with this re-done, beautiful package. You can find it on the Scenery Page under "B". Now this scenery package has been developed into a VA Adventure here at MFC.

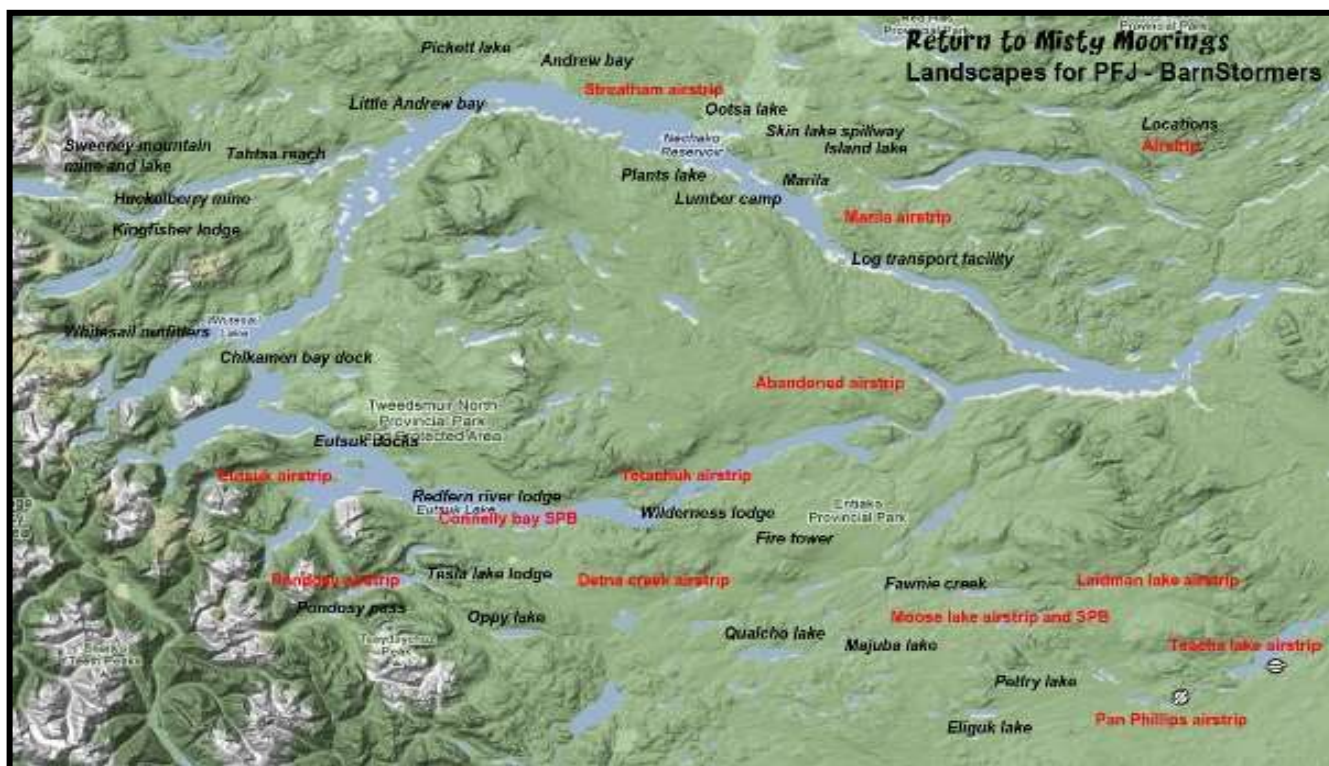
Please feel free to expand the flight plan to the surrounding areas as there is so much to see along this scenic "Barnstormer" route. Veer off and explore this scenic area.

NOTE: In Leg one we have to get from Ketchikan Harbor to Misty's Place PF20 to switch planes so departing 5KE (water) make sure you have an amphibian but once we start on our trek from PF20 into the Barnstormers area, a single prop, wheeled or Tundra wheels will suffice.

Aircraft recommended is the C185 or the old faithful DHC2 Beaver are great aircrafts to use in this trip. Low and slow for scenic viewing but feel free to use any similar type aircraft but remember an amphibian in leg 1. Enjoy the adventure into RTMM's "Barnstormers".
