

MFS0025 ATLANTIC CANADA (THE MARITIMES) PART ONE

ADD-ON SCENERY:

We're definitely out of RTMM territory but we're following an interesting route and flying in very nice scenic areas. Being outside of the RTMM operating area, this is a "find your own add-on scenery if you want to add it".

In this excursion, all of the locations should be sim defaults so there is no special scenery required to generate any airport locations.

If you do want to search for add-ons for this area/route, please feel free to use them.

NOTE: This route was designed in MSFS and as such FSX/P3D users may have to "tweak" the ICAO to match the sim as the various sims have a slightly different airport tables ranging from older to more current or up to date ICAO locations, airspaces etc.

FSX/P3D users please feel free to substitute airport locations ICAO in lieu of those reflected on the flight plans. Some locations might be harder to work out than others but the FP should be doable in any sim with some innovation.

IE: Orbx products and others nice add-ons for FSX/P3D: (Not-Mandatory) but if you have them please feel to use them.

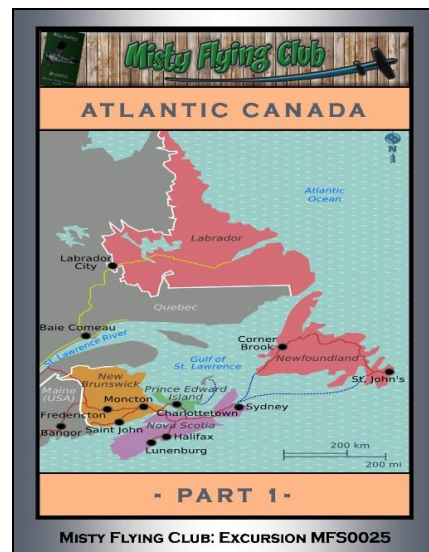
MSFS
